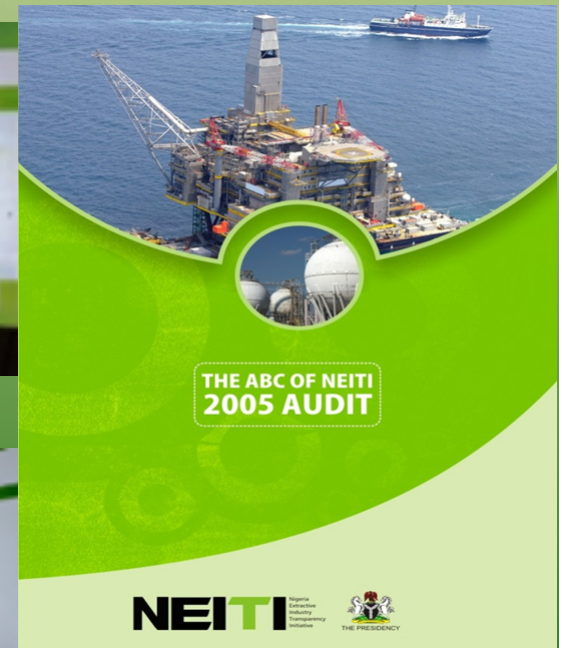

Extractive Industries in Nigeria Before EITI



NEITI Reports (1999 to Date)

- Conducted 6 cycles of Audit, covering fourteen years in the Oil & Gas sector - 1999-2004, 2005, 2006-2008 and 2009-2011, 2012 & 2013.
- Conducted 4 cycles of audit in the Solid Minerals sector - 2007-2010, 2011, 2012 & 2013
- Conducted the 1st Fiscal Allocation and Statutory Disbursement Audit- 2007-2011
- 2014 Reports On-going
- Procurement process for 2015 Reports commenced



Reports Dissemination : NEITI Approach

- ❖ NEITI reports come in volumes,(over 2000 pages & appendices)
- ❖ Raw data in figures, graphics & illustrations
- ❖ Presented with industry technical jargons.
- ❖ Sometimes in complex e-format
- ❖ Limited public access

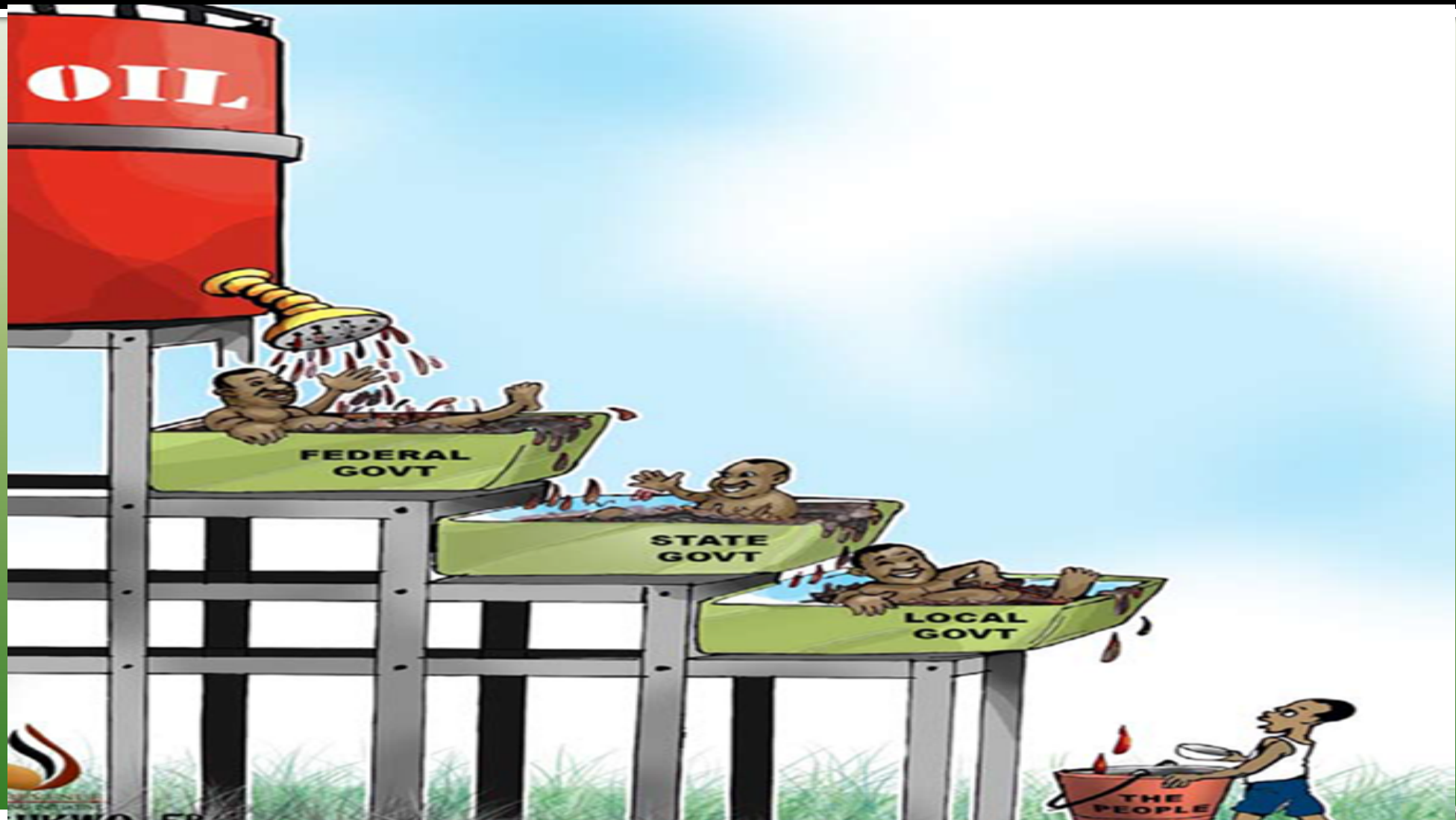
- Capacity Building for Multi-stakeholders

- Funding



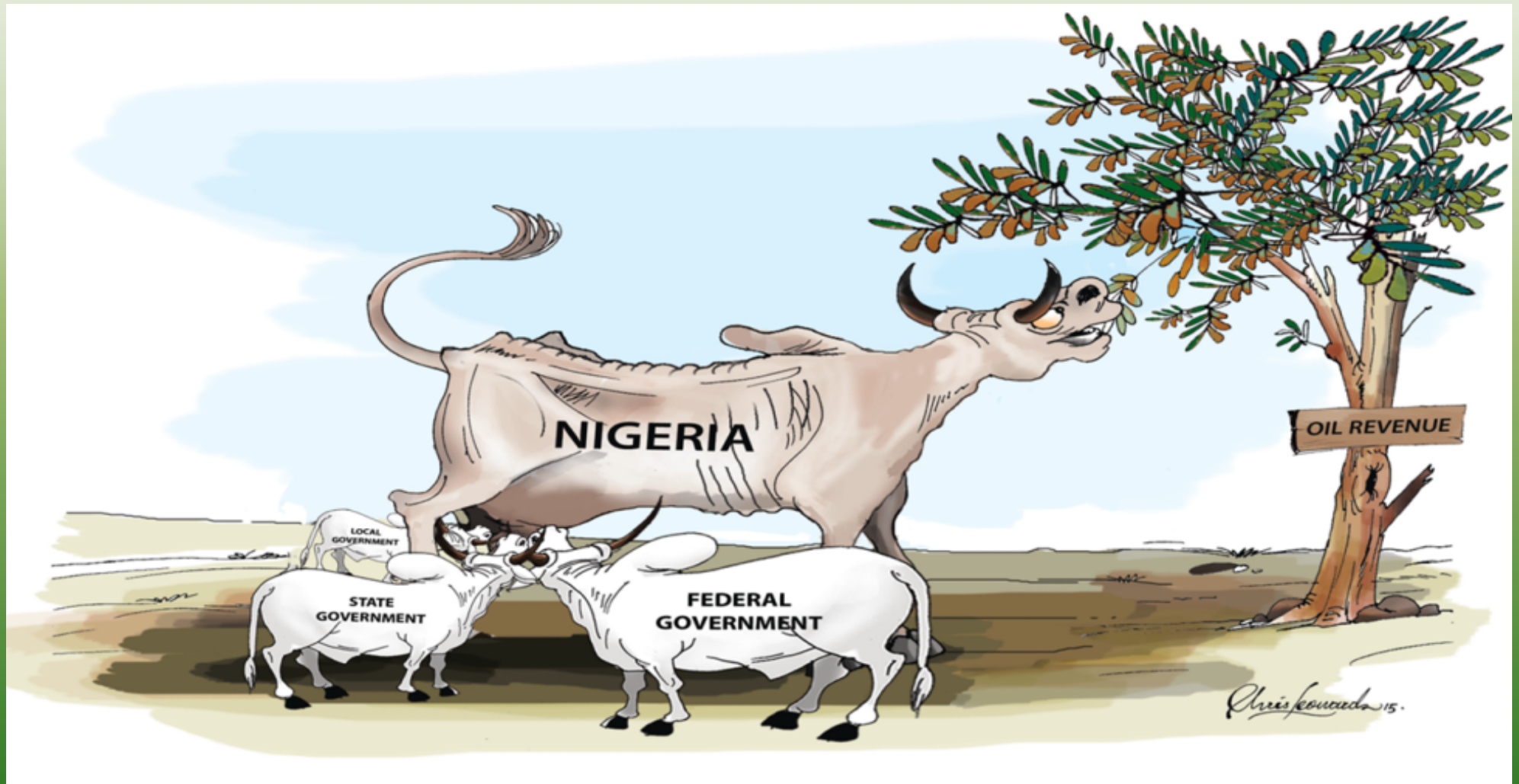
Conclusion
