The Government of The Co-operative Republic of Guyana has completed the EITI "sign-up" steps as outlined in the EITI Standard 2016 and wishes to be recognized as an EITI candidate.

The Guyana Extractive Industries Transparency Initiative (GYEITI) candidature application was unanimously endorsed by the Guyana EITI Multi-Stakeholder Group (MSG). The GYEITI MSG is comprised of twelve members and twelve alternates and has been actively and effectively functioning since its formal launch on 15th February, 2017.
